Holy Week begins today with our celebration of Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion. Obviously, the distribution and blessing of palms is a very visible part of today's liturgy, but more importantly, we read an account of the Lord's Passion – this year from the Gospel of Luke. As Catholics, we are very familiar with the crucifix – it hangs in our churches, in many of our homes, and on a chain around our necks. To spend time listening to the gospel allows us to recall the depth of suffering that Jesus endured to save us from sin and death.

I invite everyone present here today to join us in the very special celebrations that will mark Holy Week here at St. Luke. For your convenience, the cover of the bulletin lists our schedule of liturgies and events.

Reconciliation Monday – Priests will be available for confession after the noon Mass and then again from 6 PM to 9 PM. In the evening, we will also have Eucharistic Adoration while you are waiting for confession to spend time with Jesus in preparation for the sacrament and then in thanksgiving.

Holy Tuesday – We will join Bishop Brennan and the clergy and people of the Diocese of Brooklyn at the Co-Cathedral of St. Joseph for the Chrism Mass, during which the holy oils for use during the celebration of the sacraments will be blessed.

Holy Wednesday – Join us to watch The Passion of the Christ at 7:30 PM in the Pastoral Center.

Holy Thursday – The liturgy on this day is different from other celebrations through the year. The newly blessed holy oils will be brought into the church. The Washing of the Feet reminds us of the act of humility that Jesus used to teach his apostles to serve one another. Mass ends with a Eucharistic procession to the Pastoral Center so we have time to watch and pray with Jesus until 11 PM.

Good Friday – Mass is not celebrated on Good Friday. We hear the account of the Lord's Passion from John's Gospel. Solemn intercessions are prayed. We come forward to venerate the cross, and we receive Holy Communion before being dismissed. At noon, children from our school and religious education program will come together to pray Stations of the Cross with images that they drew themselves. In the evening, those who could not join us at 3 PM can pray Stations of the Cross and have an opportunity to venerate the cross.

Holy Saturday – This year we will baptize one adult; two Christians will become Catholic; and three adults will be fully initiated by receiving Holy Communion and Confirmation. The Easter Vigil begins in darkness with the blessing of a fire and the Easter Candle. We spend time listening to the Word before we hear the proclamation of Jesus' Resurrection. Easter Sacraments will be celebrated, and we will all renew our baptismal promises. With great joy we will celebrate the Risen Christ ... alleluia!
